Function first, colour second



"Why do endurance riders use colourful tack - and do I need it too?"

The short answer is no - you don't need any special tack to take part in endurance riding. If your tack fits well, is safe, and your horse is comfortable, then you're good to go.

SO WHY ALL THE COLOUR?

Much of the colourful tack you'll see out on rides is Biothane. It's become popular in endurance for a few practical reasons:

- It's incredibly easy to clean - sweat, mud, rain... just wipe it down or dunk it in a bucket
- It dries quickly, which is a bonus on long or wet days
- Many designs easily convert from bridle to headcollar, making vetting quicker and simpler
- Bright colours make riders easier to spot for crews and officials
- And of course... you can choose your favourite colours and be as matchy matchy as you like!

Colourful tack is about convenience and personal choice, not a requirement. It's up to you if you prefer classic leather or every colour of the rainbow
