

KITTING OUT YOUR BUM BAG

Small bag, big safety



You don't need an expensive bum bag – or one that's big and bulky – but carrying a small bum bag means you can keep important kit with you while you ride.

The key is to keep it light and practical, with nothing big bumping around. As a minimum, consider carrying:

- A small first aid kit
- Hoof pick
- Foil (emergency) blanket
- Whistle

You can also pop in a hydration gel for yourself, and of course anything specific you may need – you'd be surprised how many people forget essentials like inhalers until they're miles from the trailer.

Many of our members also carry a Dee's Design SOS quick release keyring. These have been used countless times when reins break, stirrup leathers fail, or other quick fixes are needed out on course.
